Maths

We will be learning about place value within 10 and 20, using addition and subtraction. We will learn about the common 2D and 3D shapes in our environment. We will:

- Introduce our range of maths equipment and how to respect it.
- Learn to Make it, draw it, write it
- Consider cross curricular links with Dinosaurs, measure and comparison.
- Learn appropriate Maths vocabulary and how to explain our thinking.

Topic

We will ask questions including how do we know dinosaurs existed and what they need to survive? We will explore dinosaurs by size, measure and weight.
