English

We will use talk for writing to develop our ideas and share our ideas with our learning partners.

We will teach spelling patterns to enhance spellings.

In our English lessons we will be using cross-curricular texts which link with our new topic of the Romans. We will be looking at Androcles and the Lion, Romulus and Remus as well as writing a letter home from a Roman Soldier stationed at Hadrian's Wall.

During guided reading we will be focusing on non-fiction texts linked to our topic of the Romans. This will reinforce the children's learning as well as focusing on the key features of non-fiction texts.

Topic


Our Topic for this term is The Roman Invasion.

This term we will be focusing specifically on the spread of the Roman Empire, the role of Julius Caesar and his army. We will be getting into character and becoming a Roman soldier as well as creating and building artefacts.

Responsibility

This will be taught through weekly circle time sessions, classroom displays and our classroom and school ethos.



Maths

Count from 0 in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100. Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables. Write and calculate mathematical statements for multiplication and division using the multiplication tables they know, including for two-digit numbers times one-digit numbers, using mental and progressing to formal written methods.

Solve problems, including missing number problems, involving multiplication and division, including positive integer scaling problems and correspondence problems in which n objects are connected to m objectives.

Interpret and present data using bar charts, pictograms and tables. Solve one-step and two-step questions [for example, 'How many more?' and 'How many fewer?'] using information presented in scaled bar charts and pictograms and tables.

Add and subtract amounts of money to give change, using both £ and p in practical contexts.

Home Learning

Maths - a weekly times tables test. A weekly maths homework will also be set each week – either written or on mymaths.

Spellings - a weekly spelling test.

Guided Reading – Weekly homework will be set for each child. It is important that children are reading with an adult at home on a regular basis.

PSHE/SMSC

We will cover different topics in Circle Time each week linked to issues that have arisen or our school value.

Science

This term we will be learning about States of Matter.

We will be looking more closely at solids, liquids and gases and taking part in different investigations and experiments.

P.F

This term we are lucky enough to be going Swimming.

We will also continue to work on our fitness and gymnastic skills. We will aim to use a variety of equipment to help us do this.

Computing

This term the children will be researching Roman mosaics and exploring 3 different computer software programs and making comparisons between them. They will then choose a program to create their own mosaic.

French

French will be taught across the curriculum this term – using instructions and general conversation skills.

R.E

This term the children will learn about Christianity.

With a focus on bible readings and the miracles of Jesus.
