<p>We read a story called 'Super Duper You' by Sophie Henn. We explored what we were good at and what we looked forward to learning. The children have begun to build sentences using 'I' and 'am' both in their reading and writing. We put our first piece of work in our writing journal. We also explored our feelings and emotions by reading a book called the 'Colour monster' by Anna Llenas. We use colour to help children understand and regulate their emotions.</p>		<p>In maths this week we have continued our work with numbers 1,2 and 3. We have introduced the children to the part-part whole model - and explored our knowledge of 1,2 and 3 to complete the model.
