

## English

Children will develop a variety of skills through reading and analysing 'Boy in the Girls Bathroom' by Louis Sachar. This text explores the life of a child who doesn't always fit in. Exploring the ideas of friendship, it raises awareness of celebrating our differences.

Children will explore the themes within this book both in their English lessons and within our guided reading sessions. They will look closely at creating character descriptions together with the key questions that evoke debate. The children will carry out drama sessions to develop their speaking and listening skills. Finally, they will look at instructional writing.
