EYFS

Year 1 Wednesday 2nd July - Educational Visit to Samphire Hoe.

As the Year 1 trip is approaching we thought it a good idea to send a reminder about what the children will need to ensure they have a good day. Pupils will need a backpack with the following:

- Wet shoes that can be worn in the sea (these can be old trainers, crocs, pumps or wet shoes)
- Small Towel
- Waterproof coat (we will update when we can see the weather forecast)
- Sunhat
- Suncream
- Water
- A complete change of clothes (including underwear!)

They need to wear cropped trousers/leggings or shorts and their PE t-shirt to school on the day of the trip. Pupils should also wear well fitted trainers as there is lots of walking.
