**Frozen Fridays**The profit for this summer's ice cream sales was £926.43. This compares with £729.07 last year.

#### **Summer Fete**

An incredibly successful event, with the total profit including the match funding of £6,115.43. £4,450.92 profit was raised at the 2023 event, so again a great year on year improvement.

#### **Leavers Party**

The party for the year 6 leavers was as lovely as always and came in on budget.

#### **Teddy Bears Picnic**

Whilst the main aim of this lovely event was to meet the new families, it was also good to generate some profit for the children. From ticket sales, adult refreshments and an extra donation from one attending family, after the cost of the food, drink and boxes, the event raised £208.97..

#### **Submission of Accounts**

Due to the successful 23-24 year, we have exceeded £25,000 of income and therefore need to have our accounts checked. The examiner must:

- have the ability and experience to conduct the examination
- not have a close relationship with any of the charity's trustees
- not be involved in the day-to-day running of the charity

Suggest that we request via the school for anyone who can perform this check who is not close to any of the trustees. It will be a straightforward check of the treasurer's accounts.

#### **Current Balance**

We banked a large sum of money before the summer holidays, so there is now £24,210.88 in the bank, plus petty cash in the treasurer's possession.

#### 8. Movie Night

Due to the licence, we cannot publically advertise the films we wish to show. We also cannot take money to show the film. The movie night will be rebranded as a Pyjama Party. Children will come along in their pyjamas and enjoy either milk or apple juice and a cookie. The film can be advertised privately. The children will vote for which film they'd like to watch and we will advertise this on Dojo. We will have separate adverts on social media which do not promote the films being watched.

Years 1, 2 & 3 will arrive at 3:45pm. Their film will start at 4pm and end at 5:30pm.

Years 4, 5 & 6 will arrive at 5:50pm. Their film will start at 6pm and end at 7:30pm.

Year 1, 2 & 3 will vote between Minions: The Rise of Gru, Trolls 1 and Hotel Transylvania

Year 4, 5 & 6 will vote between The Emoji Movie, Lilo & Stitch and Angry Birds Movie.

Tickets to go on sale from 2<sup>nd</sup> October and close on 15<sup>th</sup> October.

We will ask Lucia if its possible to have different options so children can choose between apple juice or milk.

#### 9. Fireworks Display

We would like to increase the amount of people who can attend the event. Mrs. Pang agreed to speak to Mr. Beck to see how many we could safely accommodate.

The Friends Association will be selling hot and cold drinks and Krispy Kreme doughnuts.

Two Tones have agreed to attend the event. T's Tacos have also offered to come. They have agreed to donate 10% of the takings to the Friends.

This year we will be having a Sparkler Station. This will be a coned off area supervised by volunteers for children to enjoy using sparklers.

40cm Sparklers are £19.99 for 100 sparklers. We will sell these for 50p each.

Sand buckets will be in the area for safety.

This year tickets will be £7 for adults and £4 for children. Under 3s are free.

Natalie will set up a Sum Up shop. In order to count under 3s, we will have an option for an adult and under 3 ticket. We will charge a 25p booking fee.

We will also sell tickets after school from  $7^{th} - 17^{th}$  October.
